For ten years, The TEAK Fellowship has been helping talented New York City students from low-income families gain admission to and succeed at top high schools and colleges. Along with academic support, TEAK provides leadership training, exposure to the arts and outdoors, mentoring, career experience, and assistance with the high school and college application processes. 100% of its 12th-grade Fellows (4 classes) were admitted to outstanding 4-year colleges and universities where they collectively earned \$10.6 million in need-based financial aid. TEAK placed 100% of its 8th-grade Fellows (8 classes) at selective high schools where they collectively earned \$17 million in need-based financial aid.
